Bad smell from the pipes

The pipes in our home, whether in the bathroom or in the kitchen, can start to give off a bad smell, but with this simple trick you can eliminate bad odors without spending too much.



Bad odors in the pipes can be caused by various factors that, for the most part, cannot be avoided, among which we have some detergents and soaps that leave a little of their chemicals in the pipes over time, due to stagnant water. that are left in the pipes, the food that begins to decompose inside them and from having old pipes.

Having bad odors in the pipes does not mean a lack of cleanliness, but it is still necessary to eradicate them correctly to avoid these inconveniences.



Ingredients:

- ½ glass of baking soda (100g).
- 1 glass of white vinegar (200ml).
- ½ liter of hot water.



Process:

- 1. We put a pot with half a liter of water on the fire.
- 2. When the water is about to boil, add the 200ml of white vinegar and let it boil.
- 3. While the vinegar with the water finishes boiling, we are placing the 100g of baking soda in the pipe that emits the bad smell.



4. When the water with vinegar boils, you just have to add it in the pipe to which we added the bicarbonate, this mixture will make an effervescent reaction. Finally, all that remains is to wait for this combination to do its job, it is important not to use this pipe for at least the next 2 hours, or if possible, let it act overnight.
