How to care for plastic containers

Plastic containers are safe, practical, and can last for years. If you get used to having them always clean, dry and wash them with the indicated implements, you will guarantee that they will last clean and shiny for much longer.



Always clean

Make sure you always have your plastic containers clean, as many times we do not see some stains or impurities, and we do not remove them in time. Never store plastic containers if they are dirty. This way you will prevent them from acquiring a bad smell, grease from adhering to the surface and bacteria from wanting to stay there. Remember to wash them as soon as you use them with detergent and clean them with a soft sponge to remove any traces of grease and bacteria.

Always dry

Before storing, allow the containers to air dry. This will eliminate any trace of odor and ensure that once stored they do not retain internal moisture. Even when storing them you can put a pinch of salt inside to absorb any remaining moisture.

Nothing abrasive or sharp

No metal scourers to rub the containers, as we will make incisions in the material and grease and impurities that are difficult to remove will accumulate there. Also avoid using knives on the plastic and all pointed elements that can scratch it.
