4. Built-in tables that are built into the wall and detach when you need them are a good idea to save space.

1. Have only the necessary accessories in your kitchen and if you never use a microwave, better sell it. Having something in case you "need it someday" is a lousy idea.

2. Put a board with points to hang the most used utensils such as knives, juicers and small pots.

3. Integrate studs or hanging shelves under the cabinet to place utensils.

4. If you have an American-style kitchen, take advantage of the space under the tables to put drawers and store objects.

5. Put a hanging bar or shelf under the sink to put cleaning supplies (mitts, sponges, Fabulous, etc.).

Save space in the bathroom

The bathroom is the narrowest place in some houses, but although it may not seem like it, using these small house design tricks you can take advantage of the little space you have.



1. Turn the space under the sink into a mini cabinet to store towels and toilet paper. On the doors of the furniture you can stick transparent cloth bags to store gloves, cleaning liquids, brushes and other bathroom toiletries.

2. Put furniture on the toilet or empty spaces to store combs, makeup, hairdryers and other items of greatest use.

3. If you use a large mirror, it will give the feeling of being in a more spacious place.

5. Put bars behind the bathroom door to hang towels for immediate use.
