How to remove stains on white clothes

White clothes and colored clothes accidentally mixed up in the washing machine and you don't know what to do? Don't worry, here I show you how to remove stains on white clothes and return them to their original color.

If in an oversight a colored garment was mixed between your white clothes and your clothes were stained, do not despair. I am going to teach you what to do in situations like this and how to remove stains on white clothes.

How to waste white clothes? Before doing anything, it's important to check the garment's care label, as many white stain removal techniques work best with different water temperatures.



Procedure



Mix a cup of white vinegar with 3 liters of cold water.



To find out how to dispose of white clothes, check the label: If the garment label allows bleach, replace the vinegar with $\frac{1}{4}$ cup non-chlorine bleach.



Let the garment rest for 30 minutes or the time indicated in the product instructions.



Then include it with the white clothes load in the washing machine using the white clothes cycle as well.

If this trick still doesn't completely remove the stain, try using a bleach-free stain remover on any of your presentations. Remember that this type of product should only be used with totally white clothes, since it can discolor colored clothes.
